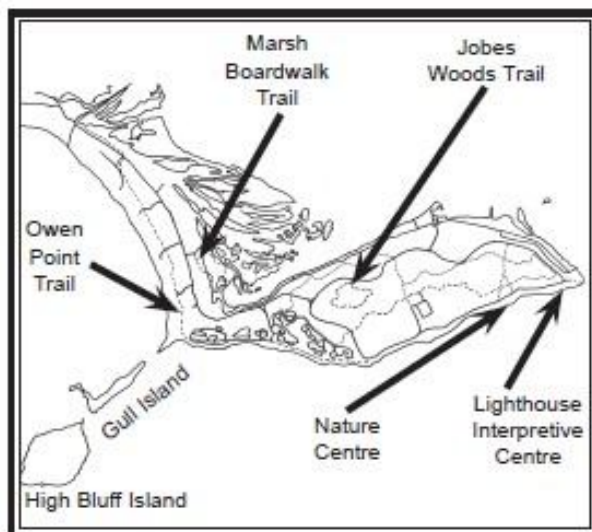

If you are an experienced Presqu'ile camping family, why not share some of the enjoyment you have gained here over the years.

Presqu'ile Park Hosts offer hospitality and personal attention to all our camping visitors, not only

during the busy summer months but also during the spring and fall. They supplement the information services provided by Park Staff and are on duty daily at the Park Host site (Site 212).

DUTIES COULD INCLUDE

- being available at the designated Park Host site
- supplying information about weather, beach conditions, upcoming programs and local events
- attending and assisting the staff during nature walks, hikes, workshops, evening presentations, campfires and children's programs
- roving the campgrounds (visiting campsites) to provide information, answer questions and identify problems
- assisting Park staff on specific assignments
- reporting any problems to Park Staff or Park Wardens.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- several years as a camping couple in Presqu'ile
- a willingness to camp on a pre-designated, non-hydro campsite
- a commitment by each person to provide 5 hours per day to the Park Host program
- the ability to walk or cycle the campgrounds.

PARK HOSTS RECEIVE

- a FREE campsite during your time as volunteer Park Hosts
- a Park Pass for the week you volunteer
- the use of a uniform, a bicycle, tool kit, cellular phone and information material



- a log book to record your contacts and activities
- occasional assignments from Park Staff
- a weekly meeting with the Park Host Co-ordinator
- regular visits from the Park Wardens
- a report from the Park Superintendent about Presqu'ile Park services
- an invitation to our annual Volunteer Appreciation Day, and
- satisfaction, as you share your knowledge and enthusiasm about Presqu'ile.

HOW TO BECOME PARK HOSTS

Fill out the application form. We will send you more information.

Conditional acceptance letters are issued in April and interviews are scheduled for early May. If accepted, future Park Hosts will attend a May orientation and arrange for a one-week stay (Sunday through Sunday) in July or August.

In your second year as Park Hosts you may also choose to volunteer for a weekend in June or September.
