## Now Hiring: Kids 'n Nature ASSISTANT INTERPRETER

The Friends of Presqu'ile Park is a non-profit, charitable organization that supports the educational outreach of Presqu'ile Provincial Park through its 'Kids 'n Nature' program - an elementary school program for presentation in class and in park during May and June and the summer day camp during July and August.

### **Job Description:**

- Assist the Interpreter in presenting nature programs to Kindergarten to Gr. 7 classes in park and in schools.

### **Terms of Position:**

This position can be divided into three components. Candidates are invited to apply for any or all of the following components, as well as the Assistant Camp Counsellor (see separate posting):

The Assistant Interpreter will work a minimum of 40 hours per week. Overtime will be covered by granting extra time off. The Friends of Presqu'ile and Ontario Parks will provide **mandatory staff training on June 2 and 3, 2018**. The Assistant Interpreter will require a successful Vulnerable Sector Check before working with children (arranged after the interview process.)

### **Requirements:**

- Current First Aid and CPR certification
- Knowledge of teaching skills with children and youth
- Comfortable working outside in nature
- Good presentation skills
- Mobility, good command of English and group control
- Self-starter, independent, well organized, team player, customer service skills
- Driver's license: 'G' level and own vehicle an asset

### **Compensation :**

The Assistant Interpreter will be paid \$14.00 per hour. Mileage used on Friends business is covered.
