Position Description:

- Assisting camp counselors
- Maintaining surveillance of campers
- Maintaining a positive attitude with children and staff to ensure a harmonious working relationship

Terms of Position:

Volunteers are asked to attend Monday to Friday, 8:30am to 4:30pm, for any or all of the camp weeks as follows:

July 16 - 20

July 30 – August 3

August 13 - 17

August 20 – 24

Requirements:

- 12 years of age or older
- Interest in working with children
- Mobility, good command of English
- Good team player
- Comfortable being outside in nature

As this is a volunteer position, there is no compensation. Transportation between King Edward Park arena in Brighton and Presqu'ile Provincial Park will be provided via the camp bus. A letter will be provided to assist students requiring proof of volunteer hours.
