How to Spend Your Free Time at Presqu'ile: Class Activity Suggestions

1) Get active by walking a trail

- Presqu'ile offers 14 km of trails, including the Marsh Boardwalk, Jobes' Woods Trail,
 Owen Point Trail, Pioneer Trail, Newcastle Trail and other short paths such as those by the lighthouse and across from the Nature Centre.
- Download our trails descriptions, trails map, or trail guides for more information

2) Walk the paths by the lighthouse to:

- observe the lighthouse and interpretive signs about the area's history
- complete the history activity sheet
- look for birds in the water
- skip stones
- find fossils (see our fossil identification sheet)
- complete the fossil activity sheet

3) Take a seat in the Picnic Shelter

- Located in Day Use 2, the picnic shelter is available on a first come, first serve basis if it is not reserved by another group (To reserve, call the Park Office. Fees apply.)
- The picnic tables are a great place to eat lunch or draw a picture of your visit

4) Play in the Day Use Areas

- Bring a ball and play some sports
- Bring a parachute
- Play some group games lots of room to run around!

5) Take a break at the Amphitheatre

- Located in the campgrounds, the amphitheatre has a roof and benches where you can rest or eat lunch
- Very close to the Maples Comfort Station, with flush toilets and sinks
- Close to a rocky beach area, where you can skip stones
- Close to an open field where you can play
