# **Grade 2 – Human/Animal Connections**

#### **Curriculum Connections**

- Big Ideas
  - Humans need to protect animals and the places where they live
- Overall Expectations Addressed
  - 1. Assess ways in which animals have an impact on society and the environment and ways in which humans have an impact upon animals and the places where they live
    - 1.1 identify positive and negative impacts that animals have on humans (society) and the environment

#### **Pre-Activity**

- Brainstorm Time (As a class, brainstorm your ideas on chart paper, white board, etc.)
  - o What are some animals that might live in a marsh?
  - Why do humans need animals? What ways do animals help humans?

### **During the Video (optional)**

- Pause at the following points to discuss with the class
  - o 0:00:35 What might humans need animals?
  - o 0:01:20 What some animals that might live in the marsh
  - o 0:02:59 How can dragonflies help people?
  - o 0:03:33 How might frogs help humans?
  - o 0:05:10 How might snapping turtles help humans?

#### Post-Video

- Refer back to the brainstorm list from before the video
  - Now that we have watched the video, were there any other animals we need to add to our list?
    - Animals seen in video: dragonflies, bullfrog, mute swans, snapping turtle
