

# Checklist to the Mammals of Presqu'ile Provincial Park

Updated Aug, 2020

## Abundance Notes:

- 1) These codes refer to species in their proper habitat and during their peak season in an average year.
- 2) Because of the secretive nature of mammals, many otherwise common species are difficult to locate. As a result, these abundance codes reflect the chances of encountering a species, as opposed to how common it may actually be.

A=Abundant: Easy to find and in large numbers (e.g. Northern Raccoon in summer).

C=Common: Fairly easy to find, but not in large numbers (e.g. Gray Squirrel).

U=Uncommon: May require a concentrated effort to find (e.g. White-tailed Deer in spring, summer and fall).

R=Rare: Usually seen each year, but in low numbers (e.g. River Otter).

V=Vagrant: Many years may pass between sightings, but likely to be located again (e.g. Black Bear in spring).

N=Not known: More study is needed to determine the abundance of these species. (e.g. Norway Rat)
